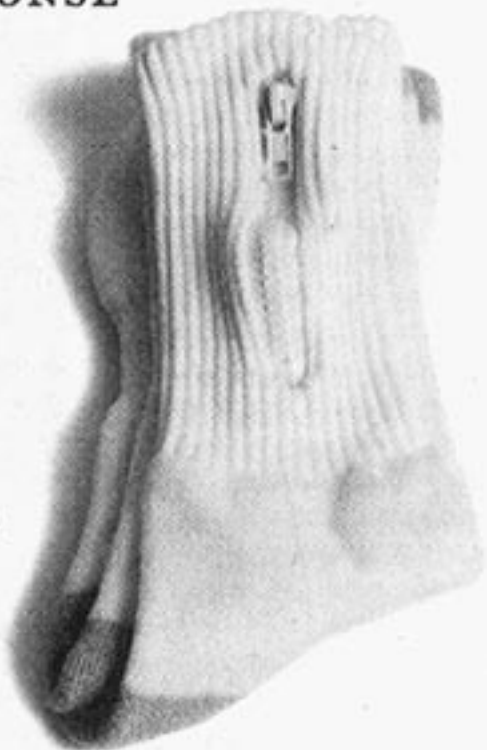

Zip-it Sox have a tiny zippered pocket near the ankle, just big enough for a house key, hotel room key, or a small wad of emergency cash. Daily workout warriors can forget about stashing their cash in a pocket or leaving it in their locker; tourists take comfort knowing that their key won't disappear into their shoe or while they are out on the town. The socks come in basic, athletic white, and in ankle or crew length; they cost about \$12 to \$14 per pair, depending on the retailer.
